MUSIC DURING LENT –
UPDATE FROM OUR MUSIC DIRECTOR

Lent is a time of penance, waiting, and fasting, and our sacred music reflects this. Here are some things to expect to hear (and not hear) during our Lenten season:

During Lent, we do not sing our Gloria after the Penitential Act. We also do not sing the Alleluia as the Gospel Acclamation, but instead sing “Glory and praise to You, Lord Jesus Christ.” Both

the **GLORY TO GOD** and the **ALLELUIA** let us praise God triumphantly, but during Lent, we are called to be in a posture of waiting and preparation in our praise instead.

The **THREE ANTIPHONS** we sing (Entrance, Offertory, and Communion) are all in the hymnals along with the Mass readings. These Psalms and Scripture verses are meditative and connected to our readings. You are always welcome to sing along with the refrain as you would like to praise God and reflect on the antiphon.

Our **HOLY, HOLY** and **LAMB OF GOD** Mass parts will be in Latin during Lent, from our Missa Primitiva. These can be found on pages 39–40 in Source and Summit. Deacon Felix and I are happy to answer questions you may have about Latin pronunciation, as he has held sessions to review church Latin for the parish.

Our new **MARIAN ANTIPHON** is the Ave Regina Caelorum, #130. The schedule for the antiphons follows Compline, or Night Prayer, in four phases throughout the liturgical year. The English for the Ave Regina Caelorum is as follows:

Hail, queen of heaven, hail lady of the angels. Hail, root, hail the door through which the Light of the world is risen. Rejoice, glorious Virgin, beautiful above all. Hail, O very fair one, and plead for us to Christ.

Finally, we will have **SILENCE AFTER MASS** has ended for prayer, with no recessional hymn. Please be respectful of the volume level in the church as your fellow parishioners pray after Mass has ended.

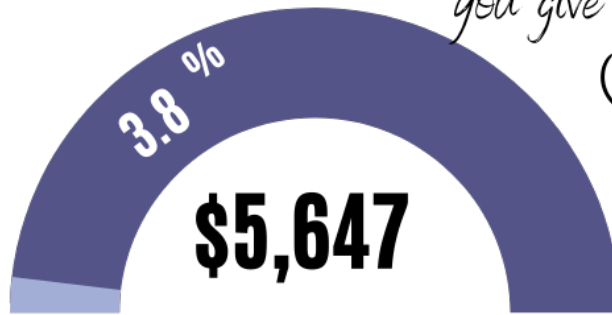

SUNDAY STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

And so, it begins — the holy and, for some, daunting, season of Lent. This is the season in our liturgical year when the Church encourages us to increase our prayer, fasting, and almsgiving to help us enter more deeply into the mystery of our Lord's Passion and Death and to celebrate more fully, His Resurrection.

Jesus, by His own example in today's Gospel, demonstrates the necessity of setting aside a period devoted especially to prayer and fasting as a means of strengthening our spiritual muscles. Just before the launch of His public ministry, He is "led by the Holy Spirit into the desert for forty days, to be tempted by the devil." In imitation of Jesus, we should ask the Holy

Spirit to lead us into the desert, too — the desert of our interior lives where our thoughts and desires reside.

While our Lord was strong enough to withstand the temptations of the devil on His own, we most certainly are not! We must turn to the Holy Spirit and ask Him to show us where we need to grow and then rely on the Holy Spirit for strength and guidance throughout these 40 days of growth. Perhaps we will be led to take on a spiritual reading program, or a daily time of meditation on the Scriptures. Maybe we'll be inspired to fast from our favorite food or social media fix and find a project that serves the poor in this community.

If these spiritual exercises hurt a little, that means we are doing them right! At the end of this season, we will be prepared to enter the grace-filled days of the Triduum, and we will, through the power of the Holy Spirit, be resurrected as a new creation with our Lord come Easter. Let us begin!

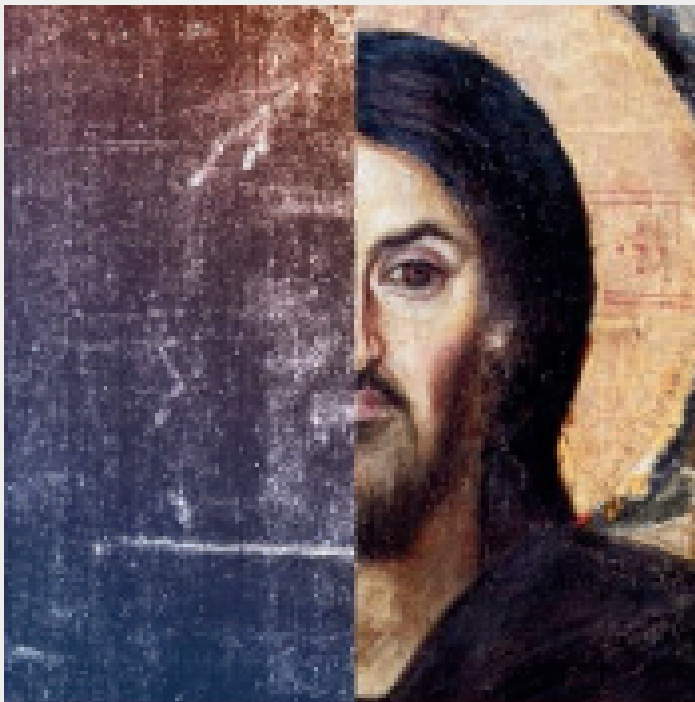
