# **OFFERTORY FAQs**

Thank you for your ongoing support of St. Mary Parish. As we begin our 2024 Offertory Commitment drive, we've compiled some questions and answers that may assist you!

# Q. How are the offertory funds utilized?

**A.** This year's budget of \$1,350,000 in the Offertory is broken down as follows:

- **Operating expenses** for parish ministries and programs is \$895K, approximately \$60K less than last year. For some perspective, here are a few noteworthy items on our operating budget:
- Utilities: \$139,303
- Salaries & Benefits: \$1,923,480 for 45 employees
- **Deferred maintenance plan of 10%** or \$135,000 will be spent on critical maintenance issues.
- Remaining balance of the Offertory (\$320K) goes to school support to help offset its deficit. The school deficit for this year is projected to be \$768K.

# Q. What about the school deficit?

**A.** St. Mary School is a parish school. Their debt is our debt. Part of the Mission of St. Mary Parish is educating Catholics. Catholic schools have a long tradition of doing that well. The future rests with increasing enrollment. The Diocese expects all schools to operate in the black in the future. Until we reach that goal, St. Mary Parish will continue to subsidize the school as part of our mission "go teach all nations."

# Q. What distinguishes Offertory from Debt Reduction?

**A.** Funds donated for Debt Reduction are paid against Parish Debt. Funds currently in that account are being held against the \$190,000 bridge loan from the Diocese last year. Since the Diocese is not charging us interest on it, we have held it until we can make a significant payment. Like all "designated" funds, it will be used only for the purpose it was given for.

# Q. Why should I make a pledge?

A. Catholics are obligated by the Law of the Church to contribute to

the support of the Church. If everyone gave their fair share, the parish would be able to address future needs of the parish. Offertory pledges address the future of the parish and its development, including deferred maintenance across the campus.

# Q. What is Online Giving, and why is it preferable to envelopes, checks, or cash?

A. Online Giving enables automatic monthly payments from your checking account or credit card, scheduled for any chosen day of each month. This method provides a consistent monthly funding source for the parish and assures you that you're supporting your parish regularly, even when you're away for work or vacation. It also eliminates the chance of forgetting your offertory envelope, check, or cash. Moreover, Online Giving simplifies your budgeting for monthly (and annual) contributions and helps you track your donations for tax deduction purposes. Finally, Online Giving significantly reduces the accounting and administration work in managing all of our funds within the parish.

# Q. How should I determine my pledge amount?

A. This is a personal decision that should be made thoughtfully. Consider giving your gift to God from your first fruits rather than what remains. Offer your treasure with genuine joy, not as an obligation. The Bible suggests a starting point of 10% of your first earnings as a guideline for good stewardship of God's gifts. While this might be surprising or daunting, do not let it deter you. TRUST IN GOD. Reflect on the blessings He has entrusted to you; discern what personal sacrifice you and your family can make to maximize your gift to Him. Pray for the wisdom to differentiate between your wants and your true needs, and then joyfully give back to Him.
