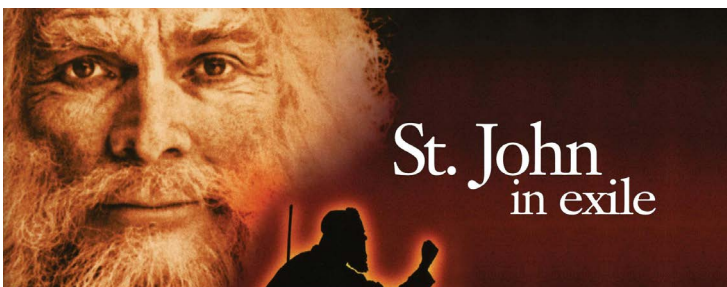

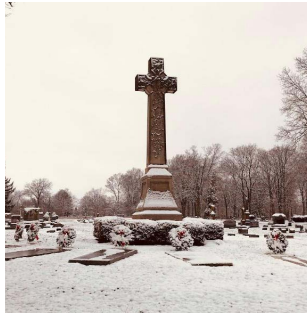

40 DAYS FOR LIFE – APRIL 5

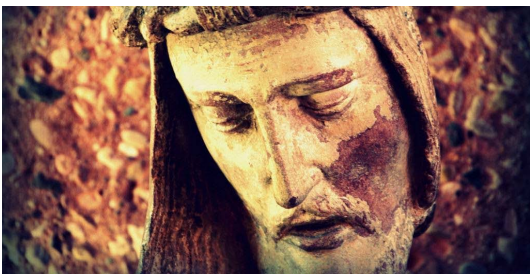
St. Mary Parish will be participating in the 40 Days for Life (40DFL) program this spring. 40DFL is a coordinated, national campaign to bring continuous prayer to local abortion clinics in more than 600 cities across the world. In Columbus,

SUNDAY STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

Today's Gospel passage reminds us that life is precious and the gift of time on this earth is just that — a gift. None of us knows how much time will be granted to us, so we must use this gift intentionally to glorify God and serve our neighbor.

Jesus offers the parable of the fig tree to further illustrate this truth. The owner of the orchard came searching for fruit on a fig tree he had planted in his orchard. Finding no fruit on the tree after three years, he told the gardener to cut it down. But the gardener intercedes and asks for one more year to cultivate and fertilize the tree in hopes it would bear fruit in the future. The fig tree was not dying; it simply

wasn't doing much of anything at all. Can this be said of us and our lives as well?

The season of Lent is a time to carefully reflect on the way we spend our time. Do we make God our first priority, tending to our spiritual growth and sacramental life with diligence? Do we give the next priority to our loved ones, focusing intentionally on them each day without distractions from phones, screens, or thoughts of work? If not, now is the moment to repent of our waste of time or of misplaced priorities on our use of time. God is merciful but just. Let's turn to Him and ask Him to make our lives fruitful while we still have time to do so.

"BEAUTIFICATION" UPDATE – EFFECTIVE APRIL 2

Fr. Pat and the Parish Council decided in their last meeting to pause funding for our Beautification Fund for the Church beginning April 2, in order to address other critical building needs around the parish.

All donations given to the Beautification Fund given after this time will instead be used for our ongoing **Deferred Maintenance needs across our campus**. This list includes such items as a new HVAC system, foundation repair, and a new roof for the church.

What does this mean for our Beautification Plans? ➡ As of now, we have fully funded Phase 2, which includes the remaining plaster and paint repair in the church throughout the Nave. Our new crucifix is also funded and has been ordered from an artist in Italy. All of this work will continue this year, starting sometime in May.

Phase 3, which includes our new flooring and pews, will be paused until we can address our major maintenance projects. This means that eventually, we will return to this important work! However, we want to make sure that we first take care of the projects that keep the church standing.
